Subject: Identification Badges

On Friday, September 9th, MJSHS identification badges were printed during our picture day. Due to the increase concerns regarding student safety, the following ID policy has been put in place. The policy can be found in the 2011-12 student/parent handbooks and was adopted by the District 40 Board of Education. The policy is as follows.

Name Tags/Identification Badges

To promote school security, all faculty members, staff, students and visitors must wear identification badges at Marissa Jr/Sr High School. The following guidelines will be observed:

1. Identification badges will be worn at all times during the school day except in P.E.
2. In order to attend extra-curricular activities hosted at or by Marissa Jr/Sr High School, students must wear their ID badges.
3. The students will wear the ID badges made by Marissa Jr/Sr High School only. They will not be allowed to alter the badges in any way.
4. The ID badges are the students' responsibility.
5. Identification badges must be worn around the student's neck with lanyards deemed school appropriate.
6. If a Marissa Jr/Sr High School student is not wearing his/her ID badge, he/she will be issued another one at a cost of \$3.00. Students with outstanding ID fees will not be permitted to attend or participate in any school-related extra-curricular activities until the fee is paid. The student has twenty four hours to pay the fee before loss of extra-curricular privileges goes into effect. This outstanding fee must be paid by the end of the school day on which the activity is scheduled to take place for the student to attend or participate.

Replacement lanyards are available for \$1.00 and may be purchased in the media center during school hours. – Yarn is not an expectable substitute for a lanyard.
